This plant tolerates some drought and some salt.
This plant will grow in moist soil.
Suitable soil is well-drained/loamy.
The pH preference is a neutral soil.

This plant is symmetrical with a fine texture and has a open crown.
Branches or twigs are thin.

Propagation and Root Form

Propagation is from , division and seeds.This plant is very flammable.

Best propagation time is in the spring.
This plant grows from a rhizome.

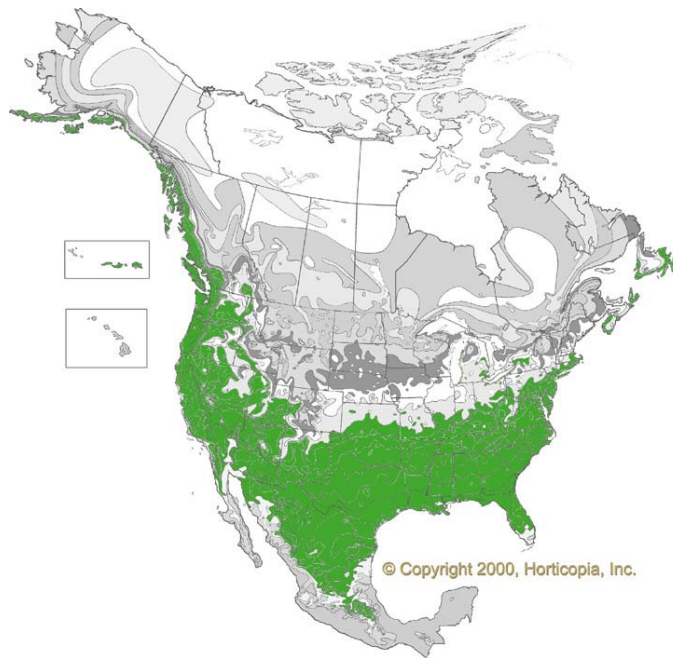
