This plant has attractive foliage.

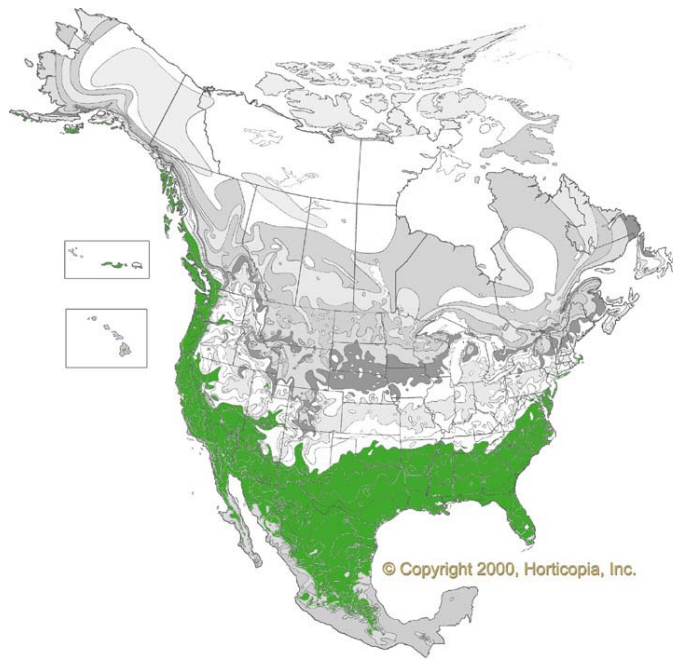
Environment
