# Liriope Variegated

## Leaf Identification

**Type:** Simple  
**Arrangement:** Grows from soil without a stem  
**Venations:** Parallel  
**Margins:** Entire  
**Shapes:** Linear  
**Length:** 4in./10cm to 36in./90cm

**Fruit Color** Black

## Environment

This plant tolerates some drought and some salt. This plant will grow in moist soil. Suitable soil is well-drained/loamy, sandy or clay. The pH preference is a neutral soil.

**Leaf Color** Green, variegated and yellow  
**Fall Color** No change in fall color  
This plant has attractive foliage.

Species native to China and Japan.

## Crown, Branch and Twig

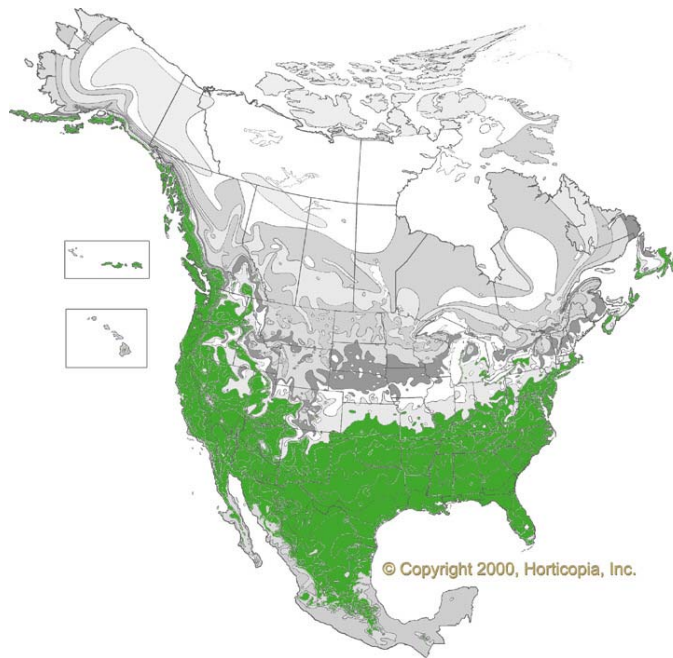
This plant is symmetrical with a fine texture and has a moderately dense crown.

## Propagation and Root Form

Propagation is from division and seeds.  
Best propagation time is in the spring.  
This plant grows from a rhizome and tuber.
