Bloom Color Bright Purple

Bloom Time Spring

The flowers are showy and very showy.

Leaf Color Green

Fall Color Yellow

This plant has attractive fall colors.

Leaf Identification

Type: Simple

Arrangement: Alternate

Venations: Brachidodrome and palmate

Margins: Entire

Shapes: Ovate and reniform

Length: 2in./5cm to 8in./20cm

Fruit Color Brown

The fruit is dry and of a pod-like shape.

Environment

This plant tolerates drought and occasional wetness.

This plant will grow in very dry to occasionally wet soil.

Suitable soil is well-drained/loamy, sandy or clay.

The pH preference is an acidic to alkaline (less than 6.8 to more than 7.7) soil.

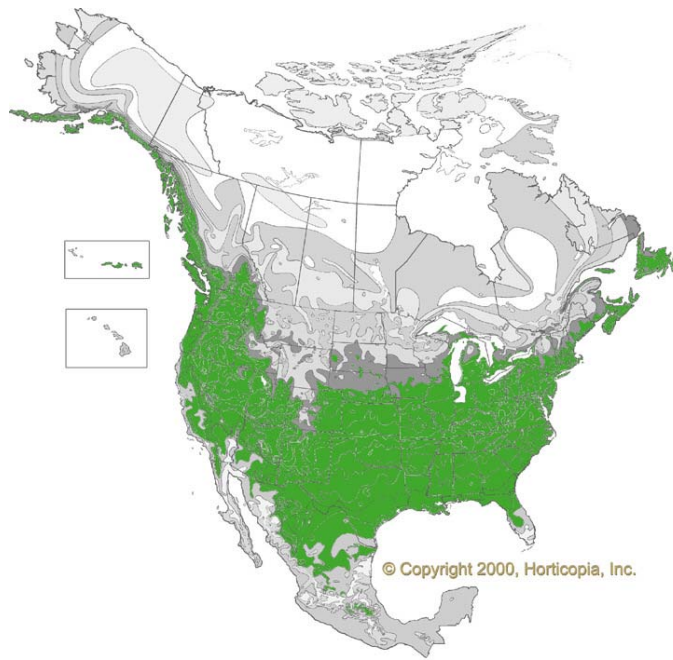
North American native
