



## Fan-Tex Ash 'Rio Grande'

**Bloom Color** Green

**Bloom Time** Spring

**Leaf Color** Green

**Fall Color** Yellow

This plant has attractive fall colors.

### Leaf Identification

Type: Oddly pinnately compound and trifoliate

Arrangement: Opposite

Venations: Brachidodrome

Margins: Serrate

Shapes: Elliptic and lanceolate

Length: Less than 2in./5cm

**Fruit Color** Green and tan

The fruit is dry and elongated.

### Environment

This plant tolerates drought, occasional wetness and flooding.

This plant will grow in very dry to occasionally wet to wet or submerged soil.

Suitable soil is well-drained/loamy, sandy or clay.

The pH preference is an acidic to alkaline (less than 6.8 to more than 7.7) soil.

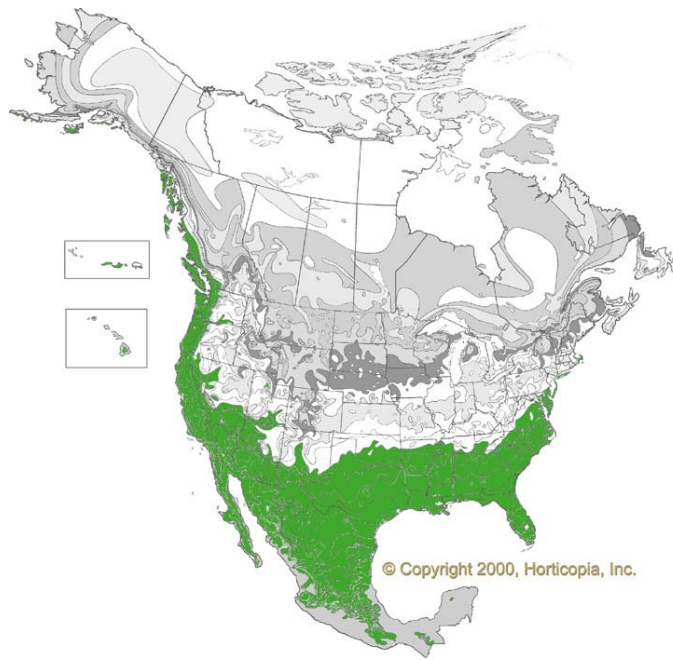
### Native Habitat
